An emergency or urgent public necessity exists that requires immediate action of the Board or an imminent threat to public health and safety or a reasonably unforeseeable situation exists, as follows:

Immediate action is required to inform the Board on personnel matters involving the position of Superintendent and for the Board to take action or ratify action of the CEO with respect the position of Superintendent. These matters were unforeseen and require immediate action and the Board cannot have a quorum available at a later date without significant delay whereas the personnel matters require immediate action of the Board to act in the best interest of students and of the charter school.

Items will not necessarily be discussed or considered in the order they are printed on the agenda above. If, during the course of the meeting, discussion of any item on the agenda should be held in an executive or closed session, the Board will convene in such executive or closed session as permitted by and in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 551. All final votes, actions, or decisions will be taken in open meeting.
